#### Be Prepared!

- Bring Photo Identification.
- **All Students must review the IT material prior to Orientation.** Please visit [www2.pharmacy.umaryland.edu/administration/cns/orientation](http://www2.pharmacy.umaryland.edu/administration/cns/orientation) for a brief review of IT resources. The orientation talks about the different accounts students have, how to access e-mail, printers, the wireless network, and Blackboard, as well as other important technology topics.

Logging in will require you to set up your myUMB account, which you probably haven't done yet. Don't worry if you have not received your laptop yet. It will not be required for the in-person IT sessions next week.

## Directions to Lexington Garage

### *From the North*

#### **Via I-83**

Follow I-83S to its end in downtown Baltimore. You will be on President St. Go to the third traffic light and turn right onto Lombard St. Continue about 1 mile and turn right onto Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. Turn right onto Saratoga Street, then make an immediate right onto Pine St., then left at the stop sign onto Lexington St. The garage will be on your left.

#### **Via I-95**

Take I-95S to I-395 and exit onto Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., staying in the right lane. At the sixth traffic light, turn right onto Saratoga Street, then make an immediate right onto Pine St., then left at the stop sign onto Lexington St. The garage will be on your left.

#### **Via I-695**

Take I-695 to I-83; follow I-83 to its end. You will be on President St. Go to the third traffic light and turn right onto Lombard St. Continue about 1 mile and turn right onto Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. Turn right onto Saratoga Street, then make an immediate right onto Pine St., then left at the stop sign onto Lexington St. The garage will be on your left.

### *From the South*

#### **Via I-95**

From I-95N take I-395 and exit onto Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., staying in right lane. At the sixth traffic light, turn right onto Saratoga Street, then make an immediate right onto Pine St., then left at the stop sign onto Lexington St. The garage will be on your left.

#### **Via 295**

As 295N enters Baltimore, it briefly becomes Russell St. and then Paca St. Make a left onto Lombard St. Continue about 1 mile and turn right onto Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. Turn right onto Saratoga Street, then make an immediate right onto Pine St., then left at the stop sign onto Lexington St. The garage will be on your left.

#### **Via Route 50 to 97**

Follow Route 50 to 97N to I-695W to 295N. As 295N enters Baltimore, it briefly becomes Russell St. and then Paca St. Make a left onto Lombard St. Continue about 1 mile and turn right onto Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. Turn right onto Saratoga Street, then make an immediate right onto Pine St., then left at the stop sign onto Lexington St. The garage will be on your left.

### *From the West*

#### **Via I-70**

Take I-70E to I-695S to I-95N. From I-95, take I-395 and exit onto Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., staying in right lane. At the sixth traffic light, turn right onto Saratoga Street, then make an immediate right onto Pine St., then left at the stop sign onto Lexington St. The garage will be on your left.
