

Post-doctoral Research Fellow Position Description

Applications are being accepted for post-doctoral research fellowships in Pharmacoeconomics in the Department of Pharmaceutical Health Services Research (PHSR) at the University of Maryland School of Pharmacy. These fellowships focus on the development of research skills in applied pharmacoeconomics and health technology assessment (HTA). Fellows may spend some of their time at the respective health plan and the remainder of their time in the PHSR Department at the University of Maryland.

The fellowship provides multidisciplinary, advanced training to economists, health services researchers, and clinicians. Training includes mentored research experiences, with individualized coursework in health economics, pharmacoeconomic evaluation techniques and health services research. Strong quantitative skills and experience analyzing large databases are required. At the completion of their fellowships, the successful candidates will be prepared for positions in academia, government, insurance or pharmaceutical industries, or consulting.

The starting date for the positions is July 1, 2010. Fellows receive a stipend of \$46,000 to \$50,000 depending on research experience. The application deadline is December 7, 2009 for interviews at the AEA meetings. Applicants are requested to submit a letter of intent, curriculum vita, and three letters of recommendation.
