

Post-doctoral Research Fellow Position Description

Applications are being accepted for a post-doctoral research fellowship in Pharmacoepidemiology in the Department of Pharmaceutical Health Services Research at the University of Maryland School of Pharmacy. Applicants must have a Ph.D. in a relevant area of study. An ideal candidate would have knowledge of public health research, epidemiology, or a related social science and a clinical background as well as an interest in child mental health services. Strong skills in quantitative methods, and qualitative research, and in-depth interviewing is highly desirable. Prior experience using SAS[®] statistical software is preferred. Experience as a project coordinator or project staff is desirable.

This position provides an excellent opportunity for improving knowledge and skills in pharmacotherapy, epidemiology, and qualitative as well as quantitative research methods. Individuals who are interested in enhancing their skills and knowledge in these areas are encouraged to apply.

The research focuses on adherence to psychotropic treatment for children and adolescents who are receiving care in community settings. The focus of research also includes the assessment of treatment outcomes. In addition to research that is conducted on-site at the University of Maryland, School of Pharmacy, there are also projects, resources and opportunities to conduct research in the community of East and West Baltimore, with core service agencies, and with the Maryland Mental Hygiene Administration. Responsibilities include overseeing data collection, reviewing the literature, analyzing in-depth qualitative interviews, preparing institutional review board protocols, assisting with the preparation of research grants, and assisting in the preparation of presentations/publications.
